The Asbestos Victims Support Groups Forum UK is demanding that Cape, a former asbestos manufacturer now owned by Altrad, donate £10 million to mesothelioma research.

Mesothelioma is an under-researched cancer caused by asbestos.

New documents obtained after a bitter court struggle show that Cape sought to hide the true dangers of the asbestos products it sold from the 1950s to the 1980s.

Many died because of Cape's actions. Thousands are still being newly diagnosed with asbestos diseases like mesothelioma, even today.
